INTERIOR

The interior was completely refurbished in 1999 by Sierra Industries and is still in excellent condition. The upholstery is finished in a taupe (fire-blocked) leather and has seating for 6; including two forward facing "barrel" chairs and high gloss cabin dividers. There was also an upgrade to super soundproofing! The crew seating has a five point harness system. Rated 7.5!
