N393JW is fresh out of Phase 1-4 maintenance and has recently overhauled props. The RH Engine is 455.4 hours out of overhaul completed by Pratt and Whitney, and the LH Engine was added to the MORE Program in June 2022.

With previous service in Alaska, a Garmin GPS 500W, and BFGoodrich deice boots ensure that you can operate in IMC conditions, in the harshest of environments, ensuring patients get to a higher level of care when they need it the most.



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
