



OVERVIEW

Starting in 1973, Van's Aircraft has developed an entire industry around homebuilt experimental aircraft that are fast and fun to fly. The RV-9A is no exception! A cousin to the RV-9, the A-model features a tricycle fixed-gear configuration that's familiar to most pilots.

Van's proudly proclaims "Total Performance" as their corporate tagline, and the results speak for themselves. Pilots at the stick for the first time are likely to need a go-around or two before they get their approach dialed in because these planes just want to fly fast! The RV-9A can reach a top speed of 194 kts with a 850 nm range.

The RV09A is awesome to fly around VFR on the weekend or after work. A two-place cockpit with some storage behind the seats mean you can make a cross-country getaway with about 100 lbs of baggage.

Homebuilt experimental aircraft come in all grades of quality, but N7982A is undoubtedly top-tier. Clean, with extreme attention to detail, this homebuilt was assembled with great love and tremendous skill. From the trimmed side panels to the overall fit and finish, this is a build that was a done right. You'll get the same impression as you walk up to the RV-9A on the ramp and when you sit in the cockpit.

A clean panel keeps your eyes on the horizon, and the RV-9A offers superior visibility as you enjoy your time flying wherever your flight plan takes you. With a lot of life left in the prop and engine, N7982A is ready to take you and your copilot on your next great adventure.





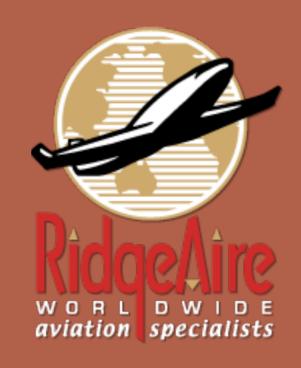
