## **OVERVIEW**

In the world of light General Aviation aircraft, the Piper PA-28 series is among the giants. With a production line that first opened in 1961 and continues to produce airframes today, it's hard to visit any airport in the United States and not cross paths with at least one PA-28.

Early models in the PA-28 are known by their Cherokee moniker, although pilots may be more familiar with later models including the Warrior, Archer, Arrow, and the late mode Pilot 100 and 100i. Though each variant brings with it its own distinctive flair and flavor, they all trace their linage back to the original PA-28 Cherokee. The result is a unified product line that can meet each owner's specific mission requirements

The PA-28-236 was certified in 1978 and comes equipped with the Lycoming O-540-J3A5D engine which produces 235 horse power. 750 Dakota were built, with just over 500 remaining on the United States civil registry. The variant benefits from over a decade of improvements and refinement to the PA-28, and induced a tapered wing. It was built as the direct successor to the PA-28-235 Cherokee Pathfinder.

N83029 is a solid Dakota that's ready for its next owner to shape the aircraft to their exact specifications. The paint, windows, panels, and skins are in good condition. The aircraft needs some finishing work to complete the package and will be ferriable at sale.

The PA-28's track record of reliable flight training, light utility, and General Aviation fun is well established. This Dakota is ready to take to the skies on a new adventure. Will you be in the left seat when it does?
