For performance, the wing were lengthened 3.4' and winglets are standard. Additional windows allow for more natural light to illuminate the cabin adding to a light and airy passenger experience, while a gross weight increase to 15,000 lbs. enables increased payload for your missions.

N359MB is a pedigree aircraft that's been meticulously maintained and cared for by three corporate owners since delivery. All maintenance has been completed by Stevens, Elliott, and JAG Aviation (Waco, TX). Always hanger kept, Garmin G1000NXi avionics, Raisbeck modifications, all records present and no damage history; this is a true flagship aircraft.
